Additional Remarks:

The Christiansburg Police Department along with members of the ATF, Montgomery County Sheriff's Office, and the Radford University Police executed a series of search warrants on this date in reference to a burglary at a local business. On Saturday May 02, 2009 police responded to Danny's Pawn Shop in reference to a breaking and entering. Stolen from the business were an undisclosed number of firearms.

Working on leads, search warrants were obtained and served in three locations within the Town of Christiansburg, one within Montgomery County and one on the campus of Radford University. Police are not disclosing at this time what if anything was obtained thru the search warrants, however did say that several weapons had been recovered.

All thefts and breaking and entering are serious offenses, however when the theft includes that of firearms it adds to the concerns that ultimately they will be used by a violent offender. We are glad to get some of these weapons off the street. We ask that anyone who has additional information would call Det. Keith Spence at 540-382-3131.

The investigation is still ongoing and additional charges are pending.
