(Christiansburg, VA) At approximately 2:34 p.m. on this date the Christiansburg Police Department received a call in reference to an intoxicated male causing a disturbance at a local business; 114 North Franklin Street. Two officers were near the location and approached the scene within moments of the call. As they approached they received additional information that the disturbance was that of a domestic related situation. As they entered into the business, a male subject forced a female victim into a small room adjacent to the main corridor of the office.

The officers were told by the victim from the room that the subject had a weapon. Officers began communication with the suspect with the attempt to have him release the female. Several minutes after the communication began, officers heard one gun shot. The officers breached the door and were able to secure the weapon and place the suspect into custody. The victim was transported to a local hospital with what appeared to be non life threatening injuries. Details on the victim's identity are not being released at this time.

The suspect, Clarence Curtis McCann Jr. (53 y.o.a. / white male) from Christiansburg was transported to the Montgomery County Magistrate where warrants were obtained for the following:

- 1) Possession of a firearm by a convicted felon.
- 2) Violation of a protective order.
- 3) Possession of a firearm which resulted in bodily injury.

Additional charges are pending further investigation. The suspect is being held without bond.
