(Christiansburg, VA) - Christiansburg police officers responded to a call in reference to a woman passed out in a car in the 2300 block of Roanoke St. at 3:14 a.m. Monday.

Upon search of the vehicle, items that appeared to be consistent with manufacturing of methamphetamine were located.

Christiansburg resident Cheryl Lynn Caldwell, 35, was charged with the following:

-Felony possession of schedule 1 or 2 controlled substance (4 counts) -Misdemeanor possession of schedule 3 controlled substance (1 count) -Felony sell, give or distribute 227 grams or more of methamphetamine (1 count) -Misdemeanor possession of controlled paraphernalia (1 count) -Felony assault on a law enforcement officer - Misdemeanor drive under the influence of drugs -Misdemeanor refusal to submit to a blood/breath test

Caldwell is currently being held without bond in the Montgomery County Jail.

Christiansburg's investigation was assisted by members of the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office.

Clean-up of contaminated materials was completed by a private company.

The scene was cleared just prior to 8:00 a.m.
