SKILL COMPETITION

ROAD RUNNER: The base running competition is for up to 4 players from each team. The player will start from home plate and run around the bases. If a player misses a base, it will be a disqualification. Time will start when the player touches 1st base and stop when they touch home. Fastest time wins.

GOLDEN ARM: Throwing accuracy drill will be for up to 3 players from each team. Players will throw 5 baseballs at a target net at 100 feet. Hitting the target is worth 5 points and hitting bulls-eye will be worth 25 points. Highest points will win. Tie breaker will be 3 baseballs from 150 feet.

AROUND THE HORN: This drill is for 5 players from each team. The players will consist of a catcher, 3rd basemen, 2nd basemen, short stop, and 1st basemen. The throwing order for this drill will be catcher to 3rd to 2nd to 1st to short to home. The time will start when the catcher releases the ball and will stop when the catcher catches the ball from the short stop. There will be one practice round.

HOME RUN DERBY: This event is open to all players from each team. There will be a \$10 fee per player for this event as 100% of all funds will be given to a local children's charity. All pitches will be thrown by a coach. Each batter will receive 5 pitches plus 1 give me's. Players with the most home runs will be winner. If there is a tie each player will be given 3 pitches.

Proceeds go to Jill's Buddy Camp. Jill's Buddy Camp is a 2 week program for up to 25 preschool developmentally-disabled children and their teenage, volunteer "buddies". For the developmentally-disabled children, this intense, summer camp provides individual and small group activities in speech, language, fine and gross motor, social skills development, various thematic fieldtrips plus they develop a personal relationship with their own teenage "Buddy". Each teenage "buddy" receives a very fulfilling, 40-hour, volunteer experience giving him/her an opportunity to befriend a developmentally-challenged child; witness professionals in and explore the career fields of early childhood education, special education, speech pathology, adaptive physical education, school guidance, school and child psychology as well as learn many valuable parenting and child management concepts and skills.
