Man charged with indecent exposure in Goodwill store



August 31, 2016 – A Floyd County man was arrested Wednesday in connection to reports of a man exposing himself inside the Christiansburg Goodwill store last week.

Jack Eugene Lewis, 64, of Check, has been charged with:

- Actual or simulated masturbation in public – Class 1 misdemeanor – §18.2-387.1
- Indecent exposure – Class 1 misdemeanor – §18.2-387

Christiansburg Police responded to the Goodwill, in the 200 block of Peppers Ferry Road N.E., about 7:30 p.m. on August 26. Witnesses on scene said one adult saw a man in the store expose himself. Though children were present in the store at the time, no child was reported to have seen the indecent exposure.

The man had left the store by the time Christiansburg Police were called, but a vehicle description was given to officers, who were also able to review store surveillance footage.

Lewis was granted a \$5,000 secured bond on the two charges.
